In 1983, Harold moved to Fat Harold's (formerly Fat Jack's); also two other lounges - Harold's on the Ocean and Party Time Lounge. Harold has three children and two grandchildren.

If anyone has been a friend, Harold Bessent has, with free membership's to all members of the Shag Club's in the Carolinas, special weekends sponsored by the shag clubs, New Year's Eve, Shag Contests, Hall of Fame Board Meeting Headquarters for SOS - even a wedding, and any other favors we asked for and received.
